Class Struggles, TO Women and the Poor in the City's History

Gaetan Heroux is an anti-poverty activist with the Ontario Coalition Against Poverty. He has worked in the Dundas and Sherbourne area more than 25 years. He is also co-author, with Bryan D. Palmer, of *Toronto's Poor: A Rebellious History*.

Bryan Palmer edits the journal *Labour/Le Travail*, and has authored a number of books on labour and the left in Canada and elsewhere. His most recent books are *Revolutionary Teamsters: The Minneapolis Truckers' Strikes of 1934* (2013) and, with Gaetan Heroux, *Toronto's Poor: A Rebellious History*.

Joan Sangster teaches in the Department of Gender and Women's Studies at Trent University. She has written articles and monographs on working women and labour movement, the history of the Left, feminist historiography, the criminalization of women and girls, and Aboriginal women and the law. Her most recent book is *Transforming Labour: Women and Work in Postwar Canada*.
